FAQ

What is a compounding pharmacy?

A compounding pharmacy is a specialized pharmacy where pharmacists customize medications tailored to a patient's needs. Compounding pharmacies mix ingredients to produce medication in the strength, dosage, form, and flavor required by the patient.

Are there any limitations on the ingredients that can be compounded?

There are restrictions based on FDA guidelines and ingredient availability. We follow USP <795> and <797> guidelines and ensure all ingredients used are FDA-approved.

How do you ensure the quality and safety of compounded medications?

We strictly adhere to quality control and compounding standards following USP guidelines, and only use high-grade, tested ingredients.

How do I discuss compounding options with my patients?

Explain to patients that compounded medications are customized to their unique needs, whether they require a specific strength, have allergies, or need a different dosage form.

Do you offer consultations to help me choose the proper compounded treatment?

Absolutely. Our pharmacists are available for one-on-one consultations to assist in selecting the appropriate compound formulation based on the condition and your patient's medical history.

What is the typical turnaround time for compounded prescriptions?

HOW TO PRESCRIBE

How do I write a prescription for a compounded medication?

When prescribing include the following details:

Drug name and strength (or active ingredients with desired percentages)

Dosage form (e.g., cream, gel, ointment, lotion)

What if the compounded medication isn't listed in my EMR?

Select "Compound" or "Miscellaneous" from the drug options. In the

"Notes to Pharmacist" or "Sig" fields, enter the specific name and formulation

of the compounded medication you wish to prescribe.
